2. How did being involved in community service events enhance your college experience?

Application Requirements:

- Must be a paid member of their respective chapter.
- **Applicants must have completed a *minimum* of 25 hours of independent community service hours within the past 12 months.**
 - The applicant must document obtained service hours received within the past 12 months on a separate sheet and include the community service completed, the name of the agency where the community service was provided, as well as the dates of service.
- Applicant must have a *minimum* cumulative grade point average of 2.5.
- Applicant must submit the completed application form.
- The “unofficial” transcript of grades must be attached to the application.
